

***Tournament Rules***  
***White Eagles Annual Galko Tournament***  
***Saturday, May 15, 2010***

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1. The tournament committee, the club and/or any Tournament Sponsors will not be liable for any injuries sustained by any participant in the Tournament, on or off the field. Any player who is injured and is removed by ambulance will not be able to participate in any more games unless medical clearance, in writing, is produced.
2. All FIFA rules will be applied unless otherwise stated by tournament rules. The Tournament will be run in accordance with OSA and EODSA Published Rules.
3. All players registered with the Club for the Summer season 2010 as of tournament date are eligible to participate. Non- registered players and former Club's players may be allowed to participate if a team is short of players. Decision to allow such participation will be at the given team coach discretion however priority must be given to registered players from other teams that were unable to form their own team.
4. Games will be 11-a-side.
5. All games start on time.
6. Substitution
  - a) There is no limit to the number of substitutions that may be made during a game.
  - b) Substitutions may be made at any stoppage in play, subject to the discretion of the referee.
  - c) Player who received a red card by the referee for an offence under Law XII - Fouls and Misconduct of the Laws of the Game will be suspended for the rest of the tournament. No substitution will be allowed for a player dismissed.
  - d) Player who accumulates two (2) yellow cards during the tournament for an offence under Law XII - Fouls and Misconduct of the Laws of the Game will be suspended for the rest of the tournament. However, substitution will be allowed for a player dismissed.
7. Tied games shall be decided with penalty kicks.

8. Penalty kick format for tie breaker; five shots for each team and then sudden death. Only players on the field at end of tied game are eligible to take penalty kicks. Kickers are identified to referee prior to kicks.
9. Duration of games: All games forty (40) minutes (2x20 min) with 5 min half-time break.
10. Forfeited games:
  - a) A team shall be allowed a ten (10) minute grace period from the scheduled kick-off time if there are less than seven (7) players or team is not ready to play.
  - b) After ten (10) minute grace period, if the team is not ready, unable or unwilling to play, the team forfeits the game
11. All dismissals will be reviewed by the Club BoD. Players found guilty of a red card offense for a very serious misconduct or intent to injure a player may receive further suspensions from the Club.
12. Infractions against game officials will translate to immediate suspension from tournament.
13. Dismissed player has a right to file a protest to the Tournament Committee. The protest will be reviewed by the Review Panel comprising of Tournament Committee, Club's Disciplinary Officer and additional member(s). The additional member must be BoD member. The Review Panel shall consist of five (5) members and protesting player cannot be the Panel member. All Panel decisions are final.
